Fruto de sua época, nascido livre sete anos antes da Abolição da Escravatura, a produção literária de Lima Barreto é marcada pela investigação das desigualdades sociais e por uma leitura crítica sobre os homens e as suas relações frente a uma sociedade provinciana e hipócrita. É permeada por altos níveis de criatividade e realização estética, que por vezes renuncia as preocupações artísticas em prol de uma literatura documental, de increpação dos problemas sociais e políticos. Escrevia com uma linguagem simples, fugindo ao estilo literário comum do seu tempo, o que lhe valeu o desprezo da Academia Brasileira de Letras para a qual se candidatara duas vezes, tendo desistido da terceira antes mesmo da realização das eleições.

Os treze contos apresentados nesta edição bilíngue apresentam toda a luta de Lima Barreto para romper as barreiras sociais, políticas e do vazio intelectual da sua época. Demonstram também como instigava o senso crítico dos seus leitores como, por exemplo, com relação ao fascínio pela falsa erudição em O HOMEM QUE SABIA JAVANÊS; com relação ao preconceito racial, principalmente em CLARA DOS ANJOS; com relação à sátira da alma gananciosa do ser humano em A NOVA CALIFÓRNIA, em NUMA E A NINFA e SUA EXCELÊNCIA; e contra o materialismo vazio e estúpido, a promiscuidade e os desejos espúrios da sociedade carioca em UM E OUTRO, MISS EDITH E SEU TIO e nos diversos contos selecionados para esta coletânea. Atualmente, seu acervo de mais de mil documentos e textos, encontra-se preservado na Divisão de Manuscritos da Biblioteca Nacional e foi incluído no Programa de Memória do Mundo, organizado pela Unesco.
